- 1. The Feb 14 image will fit perfectly into a 5/8" circle punch.
- 2. Use the free cut files provided to cut out the large heart image shapes. Stamp the hearts onto the die cuts and use dimensional adhesive to give your project a layered look.
- 3. Stamp the sentiments together to form fun word art. Consider leaving the sentiments on the acrylic sheet and use that as your "block" to stamp.
- 4. Stamp the large heart images multiple times to create a pattern or an ombre effect.
- 5. Stamp the "I Love You This Much" sentiment onto a card base. Stamp the image again in a coordinating color onto a scrap of card stock and cut the "This Much" banner out (or stamp onto a die cut from our free matching cut file). Add dimensionals behind the banner and adhere over the original image for dimension.
- 6. Use the small trio of hearts to stamp a "dot" over the I in the "Be Mine" sentiment.
- 7. Use the "xoxo" sentiment and stamp it multiple times to create a border strip on your project.
- 8. Stamp the "Big Bold small italic you're my type" sentiment on a bookmark and give to your favorite reader, teacher or valentine.
